1. A 54-year-old man with diabetes mellitus presents with fever, headache and altered sensorium. On physical exam his temperature is $40.2^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$, heart rate is 103 beats $/ \mathrm{min}$, blood pressure is $84 / 52 \mathrm{mmHg}$. His neck is stiff and he has photophobia. His cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) examination shows 2100 cells $/ \mu \mathrm{L}$, with $100 \%$ neutrophils, glucose $10 \mathrm{mg} / \mathrm{dL}$, and protein $78 \mathrm{mg} / \mathrm{dL}$. He is admitted in the medical ward with a diagnosis of bacterial meningitis:
(a) Explain the pathophysiology of bacterial meningitis.

(b) Discuss the collaborative management of the above patient.

2. A 23-year-old woman is brought to the emergency department after a witnessed generalized tonic-clonic seizure. She has no identifying information, and her past medical history is unknown:
(a) Describe her immediate management.

(b) Discuss the collaborative management of epilepsy in adults .

3. Discuss the management of the patient with cerebrovascular disease under the following subheadings:
(a) Causes and management of cerebrovascular insufficiency.
(b) Specific nursing management of the patient with stroke.

4. Discuss the perioperative nursing management of the adult patient undergoing neural surgery.
5. Discuss the collaborative management of an adult patient with severe head injury during the first day care.
