c) Antimalarial drugs are classified by their selective actions on the parasite's life cycle. Describe for classes of antimalarials and give specific examples in each case.(8 Marks)
d) Explain 5 host factors to be considered in the selection an antibiotic. (5 Marks)
e) (i) Trimethoprim-Sulfamethoxazole (Cotrimoxazole) combination is preferred over a single use of either of the drug.
(ii) Outline 3 clinical uses of the combination in (i) above.
(3 Marks)
f) Discuss briefly transcutaneous route of drug administration.

## Question 2 (20 marks)

a) Zidovudine is an antiretroviral agent with in vitro activity against HIV-1, HIV-2, and the human T cell lymphotropic viruses. Describe its mode of action, efficacy, pharmacokinetics, resistance and adverse reactions.
b) Describe 5 physiological factors that influence drug absorption and bioavailability. (10 Marks)
