Using either Ivan Turgenev's <u>Fathers and sons</u> or Charles Dickens' <u>A Tale of Two Cities</u>, justify this suggestion. (20 marks)
- 5. Identify <u>two</u> major thematic concerns addressed by a female writer in the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century. Show how she uses <u>characters</u>, <u>plot</u> and <u>style</u> to address the themes. (20 marks)
